

## Virtual Choir/Band recordings

For those who've not done any of these virtual choir things before: you will need to download or watch the listening track onto a device which you can listen to it on via headphones, but NOT the device you will use to video your recording.

So, you'll listen to the track on headphones/earphones and record yourself singing/playing along at the same time. You will be able to hear the track, but the recording device will only pick up your voice/instrument. Singing along to this track while you record is important as it will keep everyone in time.

Please remember to record in landscape, with good light in front of you, not behind you, with the camera preferably at eye-level as we'd rather see your eyes than your nostrils, in a room with as little background noise as possible, and if you can, use the recording device not on selfie mode (mics are different.) It's also better not to record in 4k definition, if you can change the setting on your camera - 720p x 1280p is good!

If you have a room you can use with lots of soft furnishings and less windows/hard surfaces, this may give the best recording sound, but do think about what will be seen in the background of your video too...
